## RING PROGRAMME

---

### RING PROGRAMME – RULES

- 1 All protests must be lodged prior to the commencement of Judging any events.
- 2 The decision of the Ring Protest committee is final.
- 3 The Judges decision in final.
- 4 Only Judges, Stewards and Competitors in the class being judged will be allowed in the ring.
- 5 Competitors will not be admitted to the class being judged after commencement of judging.
- 6 No competitor will converse with the Judge whilst being judged except when receiving instructions unless first consulting the steward in charge.
- 7 The Ring Committee reserves the right to alter the program if required.
- 8 The Judge may withhold any prize when there is only one exhibit or where in his or her sole opinion the exhibits are not considered worthy.
- 9 Second day prize money will only be available after the Grand Parade. Parade passes MUST be presented to obtain prize money.
- 10 No concessions in entry fees shall be allowed to members in any class in this section where the first prize is \$10 or over. In such cases the entry fee will be stated in the Schedule.
- 11 All horses to be measured by the Official Measurer before competing or hold a current E.F.A Measurement Certificate.
- 12 All horses and ponies to be in their measured classes.
- 13 Registered Saddle Ponies, must not exceed 14 hands. Galloways must exceed 14 hands and must not exceed 15 hands. Hacks must exceed 15 hands.
- 14 Competitor's birth certificate to be available if requested.
- 15 Stallions are not eligible for Hacks events.
- 16 All stallions must be under constant control. (Must have neck collars)
- 17 Jumping events will be held throughout the day and night – times will be decided upon by the Ring Committee.
- 18 All competitors compete entirely at their own risk.
- 19 HEAD PROTECTION – Safety helmets must be worn by all competitors aged seventeen years and under and all competitors in sporting events. Helmets are recommended for all competitors in ridden events.
- 20 The Committee accepts no responsibility where a clash of classes occurs.
- 21 Outside assistance to competitors by word, by radio or any other method in Horse Ring Events will NOT be permitted. If in breach of this ruling, competitors and their exhibits may be dismissed from the event and from the showground. Competitors names to be submitted to ASC.
- 22 ***Drug testing may be carried out at this show.  
Any competitor found to have breached the ASC disputes and disciplinary regulations will be investigated by the ASC Disciplinary Committee.***
