EXCEPT WHERE OTHERWISE STATED

- Dairy cattle will be judged on the First Day of the Show and must be ready for Judging at 9.30am.
- Exhibitors must provide attendants at stalls to place their exhibits before the Judge for judging.
- All animals in this section must be paired, if possible, when required in the general classes.
- Cows six months in calf may be shown in dry classes.
- Cattle which have been de-horned will not be penalized in judging.
- All animals exhibited, except in Miscellaneous Classes, shall be inspected for identification purposes by a representative who has been nominated by the respective Breed Societies and approved by the Association.
- **The age of dairy cattle will be taken as at date of show.**
- All prize winners must be entered into the grand Parade on the First Day of the Show or Prize Money and Ribbons Forfeited. Prizemoney to be paid after the **GRAND PARADE**.
- The Show society to supply sawdust only for bedding.
- All dairy cattle to be off the grounds by 2:00pm Friday.

ALL CATTLE MUST BE PENNED BETWEEN 5PM FRIDAY & 7.30AM SATURDAY,
FOR JUDGING AT 8:00AM SHARP.

- **Age will be taken from the date of show.** If age of any exhibit challenged, the exhibitor will be called on to make a Statutory Declaration as to its age.
- All animals are to be registered with the Breed Societies. Led steers and heifers not required to be registered, i.e, Classes 22,23 & 24
- All prize winners must be entered into the Grand Parade or prize money and ribbons will be forfeited. **PRIZE MONEY TO BE PAID AFTER THE GRAND PARADE.**
- All stud cattle are to be left at the cattle pavilion for inspection until 4 pm on the second day of the show.
- Identical classes are provided for all breeds.
- All bulls over 12 months of age must have permanent nose ring fitted. All animals must have nose grips fitted.
- On any protest relative to age the judge reserves the right to mouth any exhibit and make the final decision.
- All entries must be free of ticks, warts and any other infectious disease.
- All exhibits must be available for inspection by persons nominated by the breed SHOW society at any time for any reason.
- The society will not be responsible for any loss or misdelivery of livestock or other exhibits at the show or damage thereto.
- Overnight accommodation is available from 4pm Friday or by arrangement with the steward.
- If any exhibit/exhibitor is not ready to parade when the class is called, then the class will go ahead without the exhibit/exhibitor.
- The society to supply sawdust only for bedding.
- All cattle stalled overnight must be haltered and fitted with neck chains.
- **All cattle must be pestivirus tested and certified as Non PI. Certificates and National Vendor Declaration must accompany entries.**
- **NLIS paperwork (NVD/Waybill) MUST be provided to secretary's office upon arrival at showground.**
- **Vehicles must be removed from loading/unloading bay IMMEDIATELY following loading/unloading.**
- **Minimum age for leading bulls in general classes is 12 years of age, unless otherwise stated.**
- **All people restraining cattle shall be effectively trained and competent.**
- **Steers and Heifers in lead class must be weighed to determine classes, cattle to be weighed at the showground after 4.00pm Friday.**
- **Beef cattle NOT allowed on grounds until AFTER 3:00pm Friday.**

- ❖ Must clearly state Variety in AOV and Colour in AOC on entry form.
- ❖ Entry Fees **MUST** accompany entry forms, Direct Deposit Or Cash accepted.
- ❖ **CLOSING DATE 6:00 pm, Tuesday 14th April. NO LATE ENTRIES.**
- ❖ All reasonable care will be taken but the club accepts no responsibility for loss or injury and sick birds will not be accepted.
- ❖ Birds can be penned between 6.00pm and 8:00pm the night before the show and between 7:00am and 8:00am the morning of the show.
- ❖ All birds **MUST** be penned by 8:00am for the commencement of Judging at 8:30am.
- ❖ Birds are not to be handled during judging unless by the Chief Steward, Assistant Steward and the Judge(s).
- ❖ Birds are to remain penned until Saturday 18th April, 6:00pm.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- All competitors **MUST** pay entrance fee into showground.
- Due to health regulations **NO** beef cattle are allowed on showground until 4.00pm Friday 17th of April 2026
- Prior to animals arriving at showground, entry forms and fees, copies of breed society registrations and national health statements, **MUST** be provided to Show Secretary.
- Exhibitors must ensure their NVD and PIC are provided to Secretary office on arrival of showground
- Exhibitors must provide own feed and water bins.
- Competitors **MUST** obey directions from parking attendants, gate keepers and other show officials.

WAIVER

All persons handling livestock etc. must sign waiver forms prior to their entries being accepted. This will be shown by wearing of a wristband when the waiver is signed.

Waiver forms are available at secretary's office and are available with all entry forms.

WRISTBANDS will be provided upon receipt of completed waiver. Wristbands must be worn and displayed to stewards. They must be worn when entering separate events i.e. upon entering ring, parade grounds, judging areas, etc.

Your co-operation will assist in the **smooth running** of the show.

NO ELECTRIC FENCES & PORTABLE YARDS

Electric fences & portable yards are **NOT** permitted on the showground. This is essential for the safety of yourself, fellow exhibitors and patrons and is a requirement of the Work Health and Safety Act 2011. This act imposes penalties for non-compliance. Any exhibitor who **DOES NOT** comply will not be allowed to exhibit at this showground.
